Join us for a special event! Rear Admiral Brian L. LaRoche (retired) USN will be our honored speaker at the June coffeehouse. Adm. LaRoche will share an informative presentation on a topic of which few are familiar. In the decades after the United States formally declared its independence in 1776, Americans struggled to gain recognition of their new republic and their rights as citizens. None had to fight harder than the nation's seamen (U.S. Navy), whose labor took them far from home and deep into the Atlantic world.

Adm LaRoche tells the story of our Citizen Sailors Post-1776 and how their efforts to become American at sea during war and revolution created the first national, racially inclusive model of United States citizenship. Also, learn more about the U.S. Navy and its daily mission to keep America safe.
