The first Chairman/Director was Lillian Yerrington and it was at a time when WWII was raging. The economy relied on a female workforce and the "can do" attitude developed. Since then, the program has grown and thousands of voung women have participated. The aim of the program is civic responsibility. Most went on to careers other than politics but there are a few notables such as our current Lt. Gov. Susan Bysiewicz and Sen. Mae Flexer.
